

Program Agreement

1. I agree to use the supplies provided through the Renew Piqua Program in a responsible fashion, consistent with the approved application.
2. I agree to use the supplies within 45 days from the date authorized, unless an extension is granted.
3. I agree not to sell or otherwise trade the supplies provided through the program.
4. I agree that if I violate the terms of this agreement or the guidelines as set by the program, then I will be personally responsible for reimbursing the program for the entire grant amount received.
5. I agree that all my local taxes are paid in full.
6. I agree to hold harmless the City of Piqua, the organizations, and individuals participating in the program from any claim that my result from the activity associated with the use of paint, supplies, or their application to my property.

I agree to abide by the terms associated with the City of Piqua Renew Piqua Program.

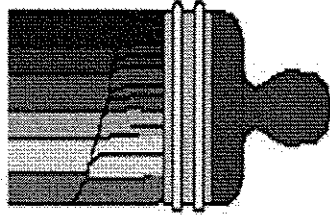

Program Guidelines

Renew Piqua Program

Renew Piqua is a program designed to assist owner-occupied homeowners with the expense of painting their property.

The goals of the program include: stop deterioration of properties, maintain property values, improve the appearance of the city, and to encourage volunteerism and positive community relations.

The grant assistance is on a first come, first served basis. Those who qualify for the program can receive paint and paint supplies to upgrade the exterior of their property.

In addition, for those owner-occupied homeowners that are not physically able to do the work themselves, the program seeks volunteers to provide the labor.

The Renew Piqua Program is completely funded through donations and grant money. No public funds are used. All donations to the program are tax deductible.

Assistance Guidelines

Renew Piqua is intended to assist low to moderate income households. The income eligibility requirements are as follows:
