The Program and many of the volunteer groups in 2008 were engaged in the ***Piqua Area Group Workcamps*** program, which was a Group Workcamps Foundation www.groupworkcamps.com and (our local Group Workcamps Web Site) http://www.piquaoh.org/feature_group_workcamp.htm project sponsored locally by seven organizations: the City of Piqua, Seventh Day Adventist Church, Family of Grace Methodist Church, Freedom Life Ministries, St. Boniface Catholic Church, St. Mary Catholic Church, and Upper Valley Community Church. The Program was also assisted by the Greene Street United Methodist Church and Piqua City School District (housed and fed Workcampers at Piqua High School at no cost to the School District- teen and adult Group Workcampers paid these costs through registration fees). Many community organizations, businesses, churches and individuals assisted the Project organizing committee/ cosponsors.

More than 332 volunteers from the above organizations and many others in the Miami and Shelby County area donated more than 6,000 hours of time to get the Project ready for the 258 teens and adults from 9 churches (Ohio, Illinois, Wisconsin, Florida, S. Carolina, Maryland, Massachusetts and New York). The Group Workcampers from all across the country paid to come to Piqua for a week of selected painting and repair work done at 34 homes, 26 in Piqua and the rest from Troy (4), Bradford (2), Pleasant Hill (1), and southern Shelby County (1).

Funding was provided totally by private sources and included grants from Piqua Community Foundation, Miami County Foundation, Wal-Mart Foundation, Miami Valley District Methodist Conference, Patricia Recker Fund, Group Workcamps Foundation and 12 local businesses and residents. Another 21 local organizations, churches, businesses and a girl scout troop provided food, beverages and small gifts for the visiting Workcampers for hospitality events during the week. Many local businesses, organizations, churches and individuals welcomed the visitors with welcome signs, stopping by work sites to thank and encourage the volunteers, extending product or service discounts, etc. during the week of July 20-25. The Shawnee, Northparks and Southview Neighborhood Associations all assisted as did churches and local governments in Troy, Bradford, Pleasant Hill, Miami County, Shelby County and many other area township and village governments.

II. RENEW PIQUA TIME & TALENT DONATIONS – VOLUNTEER GROUPS
